### Wyatt Holmquist August 12th

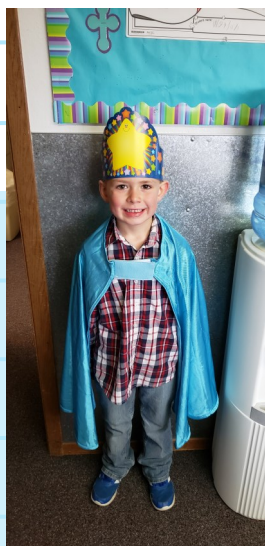
*My birthday was fun and it was tasty. I had cupcakes for dessert. I had macaroni and cheese with hotdogs.*

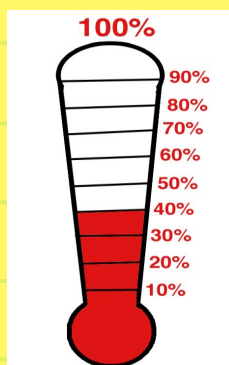

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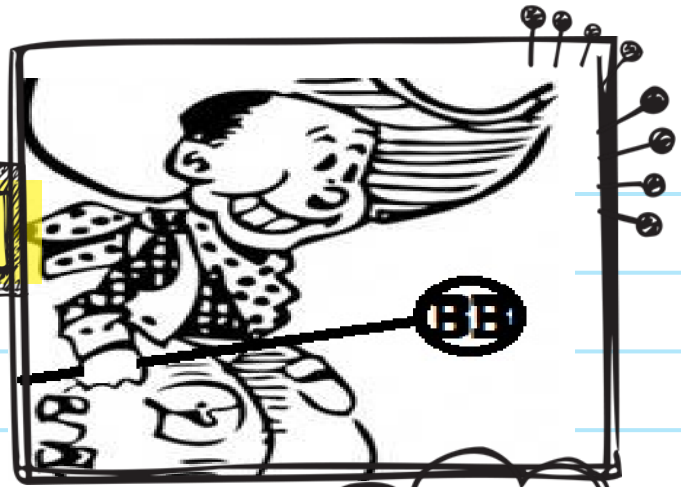
