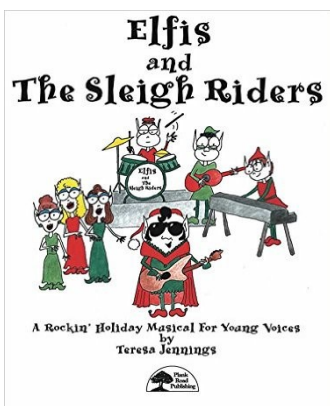

In Mexico, the La Psada begins on December 16th. On Christmas Eve there is



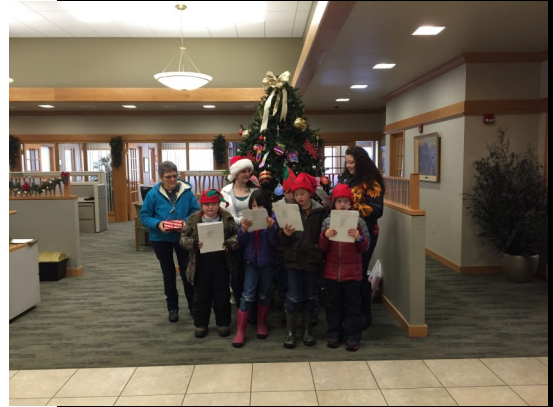
