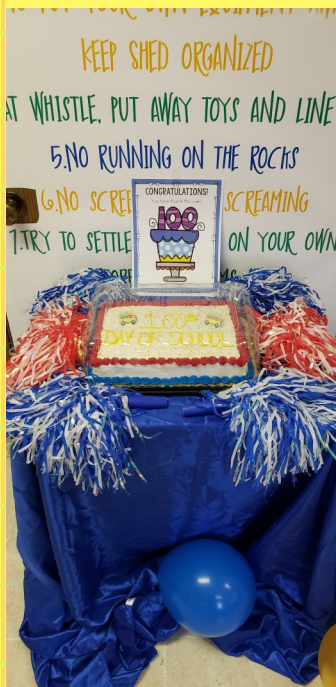


# Monthly Munch

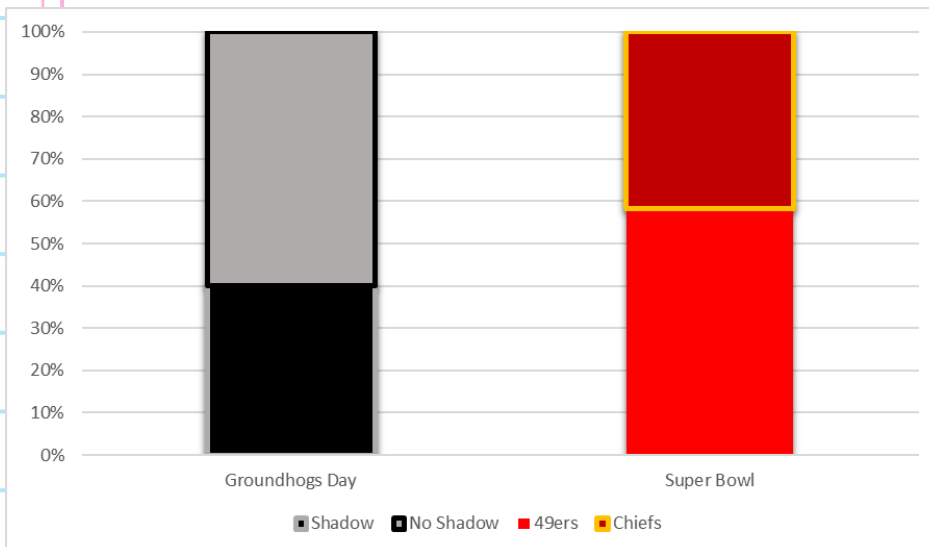

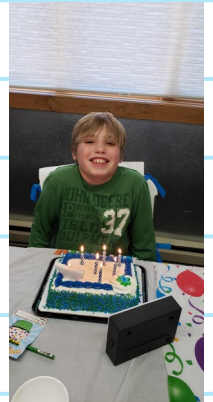

### Ms. Haggard July 7th

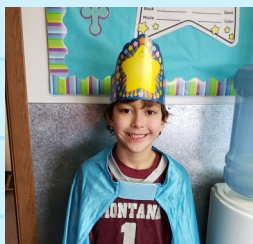

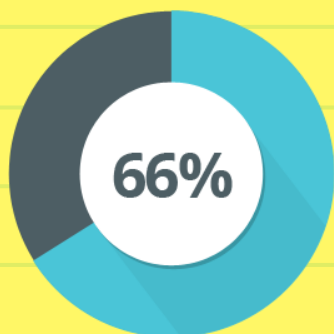




# Recycling

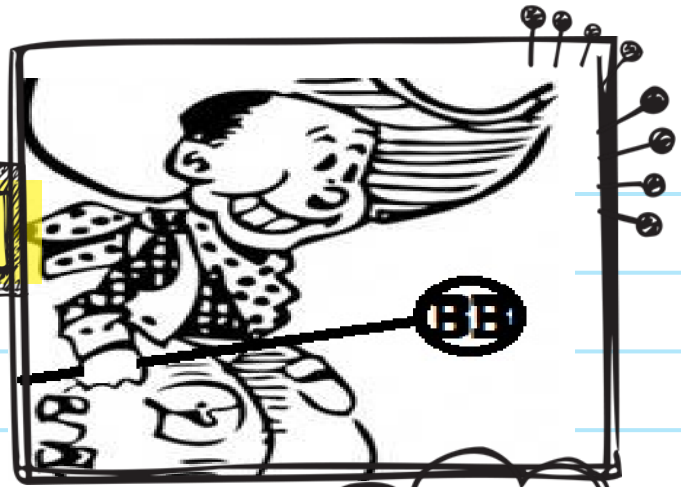
